The EDBKN will address stakeholders performing in the fields of research, non-academic and higher education, the building industry, clients, designers and planners, constructors and users. In order to reach this goal, an interactive knowledge-exchange web-platform will be developed and launched. A pilot building project in Egypt will be realised and monitored on the web-platform.
